South Asian Management Forum (SAMF) is a biennial conference organized by the Association of Management Development Institutions in South Asia (AMDISA). The forum aims to bring together management experts, scholars, practicing managers, business leaders, policy administrators and other academicians from different countries of South Asia on a platform to discuss various connected issues and share their research findings. The 13th SAMF 2015 hosted by Institute of Certified Professional Managers (CPM), Sri Lanka. was held in Colombo, Sri Lanka on March 26 and 27, 2015. The last conference was held in Pune, India in 2013.

The theme of the 13th SAMF 2015 was "Management and Sustainability – South Asian Perspective". Besides plenary sessions there were concurrent sessions where papers were presented by leading academic/research scholars from the participating South Asian countries.

The forum was inaugurated on the 26th March by the Chief Guest Hon. Karu Jayasuriya Minister of Public Administration, Buddha Sasana and Democratic Governance of Sri Lanka. He said that Management Professionals are a readily employable group and play a lead role in contributing to the economic development of Sri Lanka both in the private and public sector. He further said that the Theme of the conference "Management and Sustainability: South Asia Perspective" is very appropriate in today's context as it covers important topics that are most relevant to long term strategic development of the Management Professionals and providing business organizations, investors high quality managers who play an important role in the economic development of these countries.

He warmly welcomed the foreign delegates from our South Asian Region and wished them a very pleasant stay in Sri Lanka. He was sure they will carry back with them happy memories of our beautiful island.

Having supported the local institute CPM from its inception he fully endorsed their activities under the visionary leadership of Prof. Lakshman R. The Key Note Speaker was Mr. Adam Sack, Country Director, International Finance Corporation (IFC) who addressed on "Management and Sustainability – Global Dimensions". The President of AMDISA Dr. Ashok Joshi addressed the inaugural session together with the President of CPM, Prof. Lakshman R. Watawala who is also the Vice President of AMDISA.

The response to the Call for Papers was overwhelming and 50 abstracts were received from all parts of South Asia. The Editorial Board and the Panel Reviewers carried out a rigorous selection and evaluation process to select the best abstracts and the final papers. The criteria used in evaluating full papers are Significance of the theoretical and methodological contributions, Degree to which the manuscript fits the theme of the conference, Appropriateness of the literature review, Adequacy of the design and execution of the study, Appropriateness of

the analysis, Quality of the discussion and interpretation of the results, Clarity of presentation, Implications for practitioners, academicians and scholars. Finally 20 papers were selected for presentation during the concurrent sessions.

The core themes were grouped under the following headings:

- [A] Management Challenges and Sustainability Issues in the 21st Century
- [B] Sustainability for Management Education
- [C] Sustainability in creating real value
- [D] Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)
- [E] Sustainable Business Management: Global Dimensions
- [F] Management Practices of Sustainable Businesses in South Asia

Selected papers from among those accepted for the conference are being published in the Forum Proceedings .

Finally, it may be said that the papers generated great interest among the delegates and participants by raising serious questions and creating value adding discussions and dialogues, which would sub serve the objective of the Forum.

At the 13th South Asian Management Forum, the first Dharni Sinha Mmorial Lecture was held. These lectures will henceforth be held at every SAMF. These lectures have been instituted in memory of Dr. Dharni P Sinha, the founder and 1st President of AMDISA. The 1st lecture at the 13th SAMF was delivered by Prof. Y K Bhushan, an AMDISA veteran and Past President-AMDISA. Ms. Kalpana Sinha, daughter of late Dr Dharni P Sinha graced the occasion as special invitee.




First Dr Dharni P Sinha Memorial Lecture by Prof. Y. K. Bhushan at the 13th SAMF – Memento Presentation
